APPLICATION CHECKLIST FOR RESIDENT MEMBERSHIP

All applications and supporting documentation must be submitted online.

You are eligible for this member type if you are currently:

A resident member must be a general surgery resident in good standing in an Accreditation Council on Graduate Medical Education (ACGME)-approved residency program or Royal College of Surgeons of Canada (RCSC)-equivalent or in a training or research position during or after completion of the residency but not yet a fellow in an ACGME- or RCSC-approved training program in pediatric surgery.

The term of membership will be for one year and will automatically expire after one year. Upon notification from APSA headquarters, a written request for extension must be submitted to and approved by the Membership and Credentials Committee.

Requirements:

1. Curriculum Vitae/Bibliography
2. Letter of support from your general surgery chair or program director
3. Letter of support from an APSA member in good standing
4. Jpg file of your photograph
